### Bills of Interest that Passed

### HB 1565 - TWDB Sunset Bill

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- RWPGs will report on implementation of large projects
- RWPGs may plan for conditions worse than drought of record

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 $\,\circ\,$  These provisions already in planning contract



## Bills of Interest that Passed

#### SB 28/SJR 75 - Texas Water Fund

- Establishes \$1 billion Texas Water Fund, subject to voter approval, which can provide additional funding for existing TWDB financial assistance programs.
- Can also fund the New Water Supply for Texas Fund for water supply projects from new sources.
  - At least \$250 million of funds appropriated to the Texas Water Fund must be used for the New Water Supply for Texas Fund
- The Texas Water Fund will take effect January 1, 2024, if SJR 75 is approved by the voters. **Election day is November 7, 2023.**
- All other provisions of SB 28 take effect September 1, 2023.





## Bills of Interest that Passed

#### HB 1 - Budget Bill

- Passed budget includes additional funding for RWPGs.
- Specific region amounts to be determined and planning contracts amended in Fall 2023.





## Bill of Interest that did not Pass

#### HB 4373/SB 2108

• TWDB Legislative priority bills for Regional Water Planning.



- Original bill text would have removed the requirement to place a printed copy of the Initially Prepared Plan (IPP) in each county courthouse and one public library in each county in the planning area.
- Would have also allowed notice of the IPP hearing to be posted on the planning group's website, instead of published in newspapers.







- Chairs Call took place on June 27, 2023
- Received an update on bills of interest for the 88th Legislative Session
- Update on Sixth Cycle of Regional Water Planning Activities:
  - Anticipated fall contract amendments, projection deadlines, upcoming
    RWPG tasks, and coordination with the State Climatologist.
- Update on the Interregional Planning Council
- Discussed Projections on Population Data
- Discussed Infeasible Water Management Strategies
- Doodle poll will be sent out to determine next Chair's Call date



# Interregional Planning Council (IPC)

- The Council met on May 30th and
  - Reviewed an outline of the Council's report and discussed report preparations
  - Reviewed the implementation status of previous IPC's recommendations to use as a starting point for this cycle
  - Started discussing recommendations for this cycle
- Survey was sent in January soliciting feedback from RWPGs on implementation of IPC's recommendations from last cycle.
