## Agenda Item 6a. Review and consider adoption of Major Water Providers

This agenda item is to discuss and select a list of Major Water Providers (MWP) for the Region F 2026 Plan. The TWDB defines a MWP as "a subset of water user groups (WUGs) and/or wholesale water providers (WWP) identified by the Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG) to be particular significance to the region's water supply." The RWPG may select any subset of entities that it determines to be significant as MWPs.

If an entity is not selected as a MWP, they will still be planned for and included in the 2026 plan. Entities that are not a MWP will also still be eligible for state funding.

For the 2021 Region F Water Plan, the RWPG identified the following entities as Major Water Providers:

- Colorado River Municipal Water District
- Brown County Water Improvement District No. 1
- City of Odessa
- City of Midland
- City of San Angleo

It is proposed to retain the same list of Major Water Providers for the 2026 Plan. All provide significant volumes (>10,000 acre-feet of water) to the region and will continue to do so over the planning horizon.
