Agricultural Water Conservation Grant Application Period is Open



- TWDB is now accepting applications for Fiscal Year 2024 <u>Agricultural Water</u> <u>Conservation Grants</u>. **Applications are due April 3 at 2:00 p.m.**
- Up to \$1.5M in grant funding is available to eligible political subdivisions and state agencies for agricultural water conservation projects.
- The TWDB will host **webinars** on **February 7, March 6, and March 27** from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. to provide additional information about the program and the application process. Please <u>register</u> in advance.

Overview of 2021 RWP Amendment Process

- For potential minor plan amendments:
 - **RWPG takes action** to request TWDB determination of minor amendment.
 - RWPG submit draft amendment materials to TWDB for review.
 - TWDB review, evaluation, and written determination (may take up to 45 days).
 - **RWPG takes action** to adopt minor amendment.
 - \odot RWPG submit adopted amendment to the TWDB.
 - TWDB staff present the regional plan amendment to the TWDB board for approval.
- Overall process may take approximately 2.5 months.
- Grant funds *can be used* to amend the 2021 RWP only if the amendments are related to the identification of infeasible strategies (otherwise grant funds cannot be used to amend previous RWPs).
